In a world where truth is often muted by power, the Yoruba Global One Thousand (YG1K) calls upon all international media, democratic institutions, human-rights advocates, and defenders of truth to take heed.

On September 24, 2025, YG1K's long-awaited World Press Address – a moment of historical reckoning exposing the genocidal campaigns, GMO infiltration, and structural subjugation of the Yoruba people – was sabotaged in real time.

Despite a secured and independent broadcast infrastructure, no invited journalist or media outlet received transmission.
